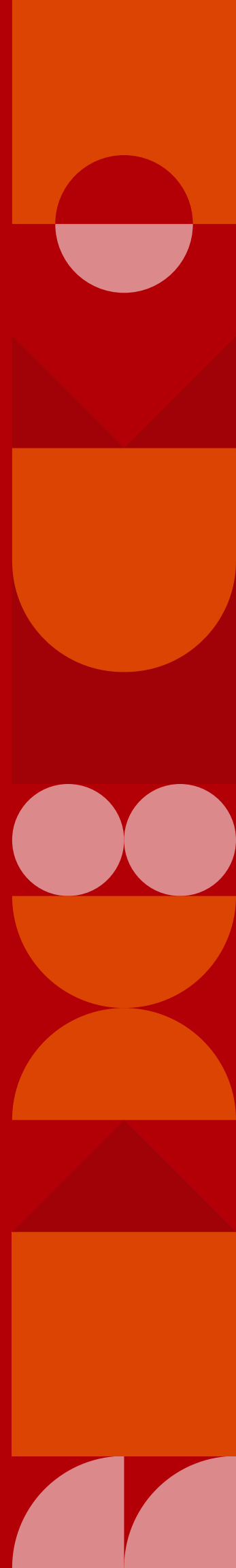
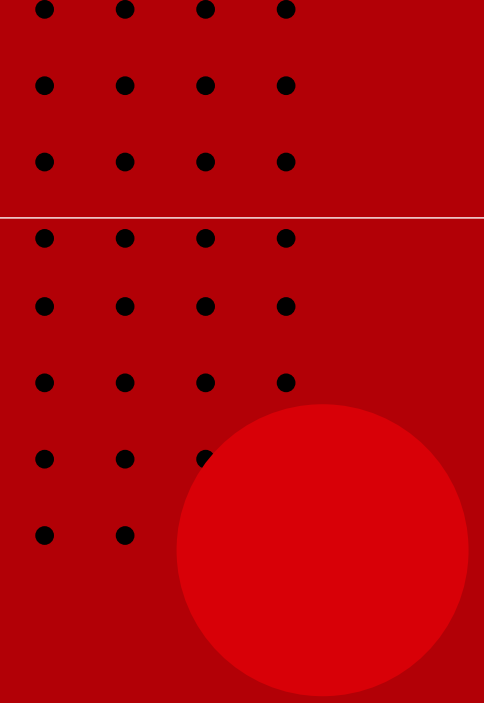

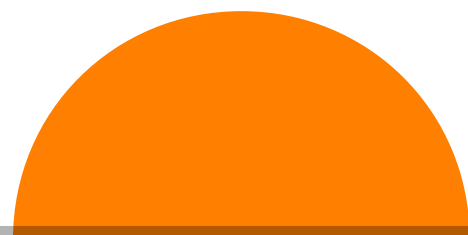

British and Colonial military personnel, and civilians employed in an official capacity during the Second Boer War in South Africa

Date of Original Medal Issuance: The medal was first instituted in 1899.

Medal Number: #1145

Original Medal: This is an original Queen's South Africa Medal.

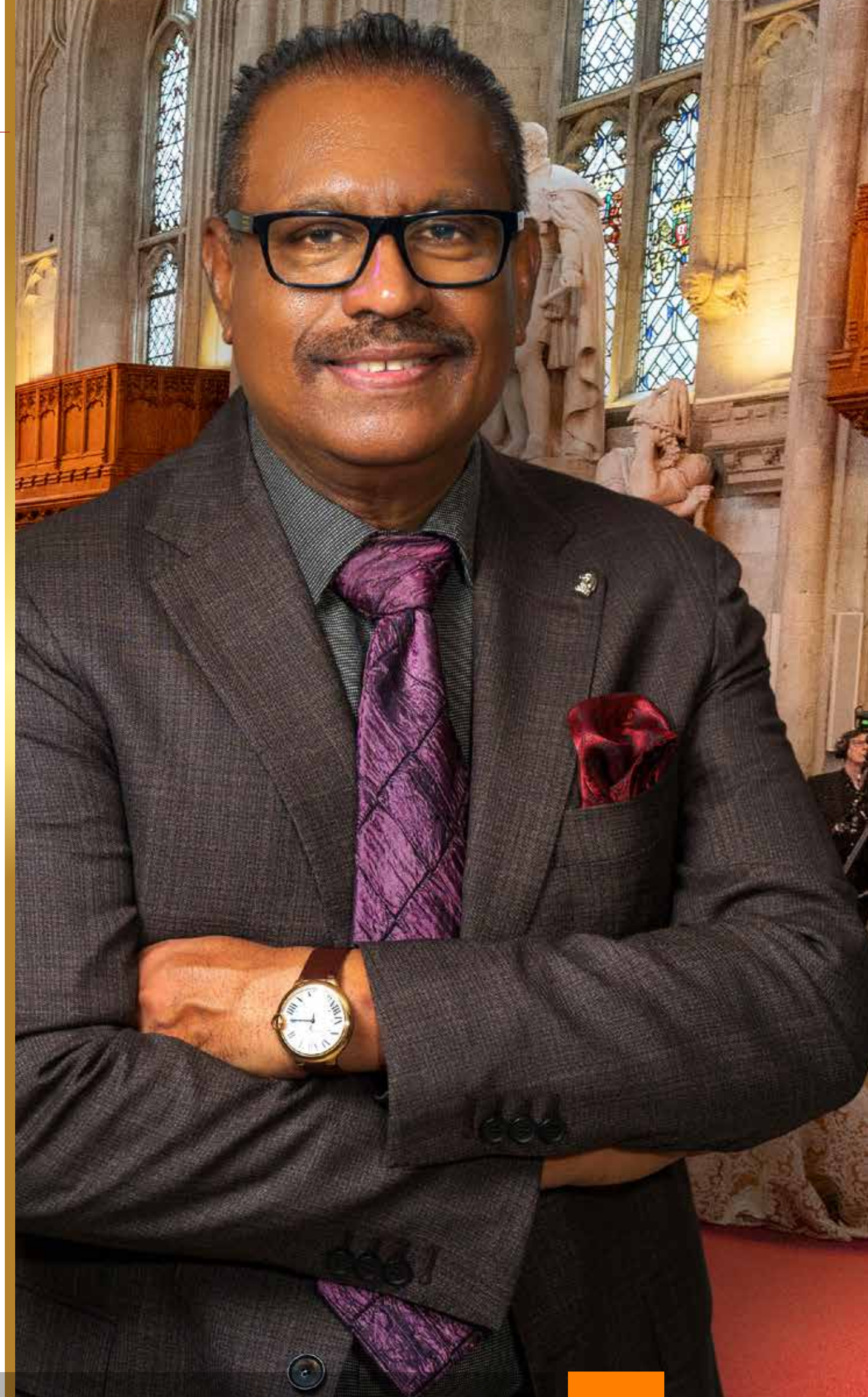

Fanny M. Cornejo is a Peruvian biologist with a postgraduate degree in anthropology and with more than 16 years of experience in research and conservation of threatened fauna in Peru, with emphasis on the Tropical Andes. She is co-founder and current executive director of the Yunkawasi Civil Association, where she works focused on the creation and management of conservation units, biological and social research, conservation education programs and promotion of sustainable development of local communities. Fanny is also a member and vice president for Peru of the Primate Specialist Group of the International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN) and a member of the CITES expert committee of the Ministry of the Environment of Peru.

Her work has been recognized by several organizations; In 2014 she received the Medal of Honor of the Order of Merit for Peruvian women for her outstanding professional activity from the Ministry of Women and Vulnerable Peoples of the Peruvian Government and was the first recipient of the Sabin Prize for the Conservation of Primates from the Sabin Family Foundation and Conservation International. In 2019, he contributed to the Ministry of the Environment and the Central Reserve Bank of Peru in the launch of a 1 Peruvian Nuevo Sol coin inspired by the yellow-tailed woolly monkey, with the coin based on one of his photographs of this species.

In this year, 2023, she has been announced as the inaugural winner of the Emerging Conservationist Award, an award given by the prestigious Indianapolis Prize, for her career and contribution to the conservation of threatened primates in Peru, such as the yellow-tailed woolly monkey, the Andean night monkey, and the monkey machin of Tumbes. She has also received the “Carlos Ponce del Prado Conservation Award” in the category of “Artificer of Conservation” for her contribution to biodiversity conservation and sustainable development in Peru. In addition, she has been included by Forbes magazine as one of the 50 most powerful women in Peru.

Jackie Siegel is best known for her role in the award-winning documentary feature, *Queen of Versailles* (Magnolia Pictures), which premiered at the Sundance Film Festival in 2012 and continues to be one of the most popular movies on Netflix. The documentary was also included on *Vogue's* list of "66 Best Documentaries of All Time." Jackie earned the title "Queen" when in 2003 she and husband, David Siegel, began an extravagant project to build the largest private residence in the U.S. named Versailles.

However, the ambitious construction abruptly halted to a grind as the 2008 recession dented their fortune. The rise and fall of their grand ambitions were captured in the critically acclaimed 2012 documentary based on their plans for the 108,000 square-foot mansion near Orlando, FL. Currently on track for completion in the fall of 2024, there's rumor that the French original may look modest by comparison to the Siegel's version with 13 bedrooms, 10 kitchens, an ice skating rink, not to mention a 5,000-square-foot closet. As an intriguing fixture in pop culture, Siegel has made headlines with mainstream media (including *Us Weekly* and *People Magazine*) and has appeared on hit television shows like *Bravo's Flipping Out* and *Watch What Happens Live with Andy Cohen*.

She also appeared as a guest on the reality series, *Below Deck*. Her new TV series *The Queen of Versailles Reigns* again has aired in Discovery Plus with a 2nd season to debut in HGTV this fall. She is also in the process of developing a Broadway show with the same producers of *Wicked* with Kristen Chenoweth accepting the role as *The Queen of Versailles*. Mrs. Siegel seats on the board of Westgate Resorts, the largest privately owned timeshare organization while she maintains investments in various real estate and alternative investments. However, in 2016, David and Jackie's world changed forever when their then 18-year daughter, Victoria, died of a drug overdose. This tragedy has trajected them into a new life purpose: to save lives

through drug prevention programs. As a result, the Siegels have created a foundation in Victoria's memory called Victoria's Voice.

Its purpose is to bring drug prevention education into the schools, offer healthy social media opportunities for young people, and assist first responders in receiving and administering Narcan (Naloxone) to an overdose victim, which has proven to save lives. When Victoria was discovered, she still had a heartbeat. It's possible she could have been saved if the first responders had been equipped with Narcan. She continues to schedule a full calendar as a model, actress, and philanthropist, but since Victoria's loss, more priority is now given to Victoria's Voice foundation as she and her husband tirelessly work to bring local communities, state legislatures and even the federal government in agreement to do more about the opioid epidemic and its often tragic results. The former Mrs. Florida America is actively involved in the national Mrs. America organization and now many of the beauty queens have become outspoken advocates of Victoria's Voice and saving lives.

After Victoria's death, a friend of hers suggested to the Siegels that they look in her bedside table and read through a diary Victoria kept. They decided to leave it just as she left it with drawings, poems, heartfelt feelings of loneliness and sadness. It is a very emotionally-charged read that all need to take heed of. It is a glimpse into the heart of a hurting teen that reveals to parents not uncommon struggles of their children. "If only one life can be saved through our efforts," says Mrs. Siegel, "it will have been worth all of the time, effort, and money." The book is aptly titled, "Victoria's Voice."

In the grand narrative of the British Empire, there stands a testament to courage and service, a medal minted not for the multitude, but the valiant and committed.

This token of distinction was none other than the Queen's South Africa Medal, a prestigious recognition conferred upon those who exhibited exceptional courage during the Second Boer War.

The Queen's South Africa Medal was awarded to all British led forces who served in South Africa from 11 October 1899 to the end of the war on 31 May 1902. Those who qualified for the medal included members of the British Army, Royal Navy, hospital nurses colonial forces from Australia, Canada, New Zealand, India, as well as locally raised units from the Cape of Good Hope, the Natal and "hensoppers" (collaborators, literally "hands-uppers") from the South African Republic and Orange Free State, civilians employed in an official capacity, war correspondents, and non-enlisted men of whatever nationality who drew military pay. This included those such as the New Zealand 10th Contingent, who arrived in Durban in May 1902, but saw no fighting.

The Queen's South Africa Medal, a tangible manifestation of valour, before as many as twenty-six clasps, each symbolising participation in distinct actions and campaigns.

These clasps reflect the tireless commitment of those in the face of overwhelming odds - an attribute that mirrors the dedica-

tion of the GOOD Fellows in sculpting the edifice of sustainable wealth management

The illustrious medal's ribbon bar, indicative of an unwavering adherence to duty, reverberates in the GOOD Fellows' ceaseless endeavors to redefine global wealth. Just as the Queen's South Africa Medal commemorated service and courage, the GOOD Fellow Awards recognise relentless service in the often-turbulent theater of global wealth.
